

## **Worship And The Glory Of God.**

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### **1. John 4:19-24, Matthew 15:8-9, Matthew 12:6, Philippians 3:7-8**

What does Jesus mean when He says that the true worshippers worship 'in spirit and in truth'?  
What practical implications does what He says have for us as we seek to grow in our worship of God?

### **2. Romans 1:18-28, 2 Corinthians 4:3-6**

In the passage in Romans, Paul tells us that at root, our sinful behaviour is the product of our having exchanged the glory of God for a lie, and for images of ourselves. The remedy is then presented in the passage in 2 Corinthians: God shines His glory into our hearts, so that we can behold it, and treasure it and Him and prefer Him over all. This suggests, among other things, that if we want to overcome sin then we need to see God as more desirable than anything else. How can we grow in our desire for God?

### **3. Ephesians 5:18-21**

Why is Paul concerned that believers should sing? What does singing do that speech and other actions don't do? What do all of your discussions so far suggest about how we should approach sung worship?
