1. **Isaiah 55:6-11; Leviticus 18:1-5; Psalms 95:10-11; Romans 11:33-36; Luke 9:51-56; Matthew 5:45-48; 1 Samuel 16:6-7**

His ways and thoughts are far higher than our own according to scriptures. Share any experiences on how you have dealt with some of the high expectations we find in the Word, and how you have handled the seemingly debatable and difficult to understand issues in your daily walk with God.

2. **Psalms 119:5-6;57-60; Psalms 25:1-5; Isaiah 48:16-18; 1 John 2:3-6; Psalms 119:9-11; Psalms 119:160-170; Hebrews 4:12-13**
